- **rating tournament** with rating for FIDE and DWZ

- **financial prizes** in CZK*: 8 000, 6 000, 4 000, 3 000, 2 000, 1 000, 500, 500, 500, best woman 500, best player up to 16 years of age 500, prizes for the best players with ELO FIDE 2000-2149, 1850-1999, 1700-1849, 1550-1699, 1400-1549, smaller than 1400 and for the best player without ELO FIDE – in each of these categories 500 (**30 000 altogether**, fusion of prizes is possible)
- material prizes for other players, women, seniors over 60 years of age and youngsters up to 16 years of age

E) 16th August 2018: open tournament in rapid chess

F) 14th August 2018: open blitz tournament

- participation of players without age and performance limitations
- **rating** for blitz ELO FIDE

- **financial and material prizes** according to the number of participants *
- **starting fee** 2,0 EUR:
- **fees for rating of the tournament results for ELO in the amount of 0,5 EUR per player** charged according to the economic directive of the Chess Federation of the Czech Republic **are not included in the starting fee and will be paid by participants during the registration**
- applications for this tournament are not registered and it is possible to register for it only on the day of launching of the tournament

System:

- A, B tournaments – round system of 9 rounds
- C, D tournaments – Swiss system of 9 rounds
- E tournament – Swiss system of 7 rounds
- F tournament - Swiss system of 11 rounds

Criteria used for ranking and prizes distribution:

- A, B tournaments – 1. number of points, 2. S.-B., 3. mutual game, 4. lot, prizes are divided equally among players with the same number of points
- C, D, E and F tournaments - 1. number of points, 2. Buchholz Cut 1, 3. Buchholz, 4. Sonnenborg-Bergen, 5. the greater number of games played with black. Prizes in tournaments C and D are distributed according to Hort system among such number of players which corresponds to the number of advertised prizes; prizes in tournaments E and F are not divided

Rate of the game:

- A, B, C, D tournaments 2x 1,5 h/40 + 30 min. + 30 s/move, waiting time is 1 h in case of late arrival
- E tournament 2 x 10 min. + 5s/move
- F tournament 2 x 3 min. + 2s/move
